Dear Friends,

Several years ago I came across an academic booklet called "Hardwired to Connect." It was a study of young people and how they grow and develop emotionally. The evidence was clear that when young people had significant relationships with adults other than their parents, they were more likely to thrive as they grew into adulthood. As the title suggests, connections with other people were fundamental to their growth and development. This make sense to those of us who are part of a church community. We know the benefits of being connected with one another and the larger world around us.

As our culture has grown more and more individualized, these connections have become less prevalent. Churches are one of the few places left in our communities where enerations regularly intermingle. It is easy to lament the changes in our society, and it is important for us to think of ways to respond to the deficits we identify. Individualism has become such a powerful driver in our culture. We choose the shows and when to watch them on TV. We eay individual meals while doing other things. We drive places alone in our cars. I was completing a survey a few weeks ago and it asked about what time I first interacted with another person. For many people the answer is lunchtime, dinner, or maybe not at all.

Service agencies often have as a goal for people receiving service "self-sufficiency." I think that is the wrong goal. We are made to connect with each other. We are made for community. The idea of self-sufficiency seems to suggest that we can get along on our own, that we are not dependent on one another. The truth is that we do need other people. We will always be interdependent. Let us find ways to embrace our connections, to build stronger ones and even new connections with each other and our community. In so doing we are becoming who we are meant to be.
