- 6 Pray for the peace of Jerusalem: "May they prosper who love you.
- 7 Peace be within your walls, and security within your towers."
- 8 For the sake of my relatives and friends I will say, "Peace be within you."
- 9 For the sake of the house of the LORD our God, I will seek your good.

Let us be glad and rejoice as we work for peace, for justice, for love, for kindness as we build our munity together.
