During this month I encourage you to notice the water around you. Whether it is coming from the faucet in your sink or standing in your yard, trickling down a hillside or roaring over a cliff, water is life. It is amazing and healing and cleansing. it is one of God's good gifts to us, one we often take for granted. Spend time this month in gratitude for the water that blesses us.
