The Church boiler system began to have problems the end of January and by February a dedicated crew took turns restarting the boiler manually when necessary to keep the building warm. Then record cold temperatures caused a hot water pipe behind the sink in the basement kitchen to freeze and burst. The burst pipe was discovered early enough so that the water damage was limited. The water leak has been fixed and the necessary repairs to the kitchen will be done. Repairs to the floor in the dining room are planned. Needed boiler modifications have been completed.

A big thank you to all who helped with the boiler problem and a thank you to the membership for their patience while the problem was being fixed. The Spirit of First Pres certainly was evident during this trying time.


This year Ash Wednesday is March 6. Ash Wednesday is the first day of *Lent* and occurs 46 days before Easter. It is a moveable fast, falling on a different date each year because it is dependent on the date of Easter. It can occur as early as February 4 or as late as March 10. Sundays are not counted as Lenten fast days so Lent is for 40 days, mirroring the 40 days that Jesus spent fasting in the wilderness before starting his ministry.

Chris and Bill who hold Bible Study classes each week and sponsor the summer hot dog ministry. Carolyn who volunteers her services as Assistant Treasurer.


Jane who drives the church van each Sunday and for the children's outings.
