Again this year First Pres is participating in the Operation Christmas Child Shoebox Ministry. This worldwide outreach, a project of Samaritan's Purse, ministers to children in war-torn and faminestricken countries. In just two decades it has inspired everyday people to provide gift-filled shoeboxes to needy children in 130 countries.

To fill a box you choose either boy or girl and an age group. Age groups are 2-4, 5-9, 10-14. You fill the box with items appropriate for the age group you have chosen.

A \$9.00 donation is requested, if possible, to cover the cost of shipping the box. Checks are requested and should be made out to Samaritan's Purse (note "OCC" on the memo line) and place it in an envelope on top of the items inside the shoebox. Print and cut out an appropriate boy/girl label. Mark the appropriate boy/girl label and the age category. Tape the label to the top of the box. Labels and a list of age appropriate gifts can be found on the table in the Fellowship Hall. Donations of new items are accepted. The Sunday School children will make up boxes.

Shoeboxes and more information will be available October 6th. The last day to drop off boxes is Sunday, November 10th, Contact Lis Slenk for more information.
